Cashmere is obtained from a specific type of goat : cashmere goats.

- ✓ **Wear & Tear:**
 - Durable and long lasting.
- ✓ **Biodegradability:**
 - Chemical treatment to prevent the fibre produces felting during the laundering.
- ✓ **Ability to build dye:**
 - Can be dyed but is often left in its natural colour.
- ✓ **Temperature Control/Insolation:**
 - Known for its hygroscopic properties that allows cashmere to adjust itself depending on the hair humidity.
- ✓ **Softness:**
 - Cashmere is known as the softest fibre. It is made with the soft undercoat of hair that compose the double fleece of the goat.
- ✓ **Bacteria:**
 - Anti-bacteria properties present.
- ✓ **Yield Efficiency:**
 - Low efficiency as it is collected from wild populations. One goat produces about 150 grams of cashmere per year.
